

Prof. Foxon obtained his B.Sc. in Physics at Kings College London in 1961 and his Ph.D. in Materials Science in 1965 also at London University. He then worked first as a BICC Research Fellow at the University of Surrey and subsequently as a Post-Doctoral Research Fellow at the University of Alberta in Canada from 1967 to 1969. In 1969 he joined the Mullard (later Philips) Research Laboratories where together with Prof. Joyce he began the study of Molecular Beam Epitaxy. In Dec. 1989 he was appointed as a visiting Prof. at the Technical University of Eindhoven.
