



Heinz A. Preisig (1951), from Herisau in Switzerland set off, as a teenager, to learn the profession of a chemical laboratory assistant (1968-71). He then decided to continue education and earned the HTL degree in chemistry, the analogue to the Dutch HTS (1974). Just in time a new opportunity opened with the introduction of a transition course, providing a new path into the Swiss Federal Institute of Technology where he earned the Diploma in Chemical Engineering (1978) and later his PhD with David W.T. Rippin (1984).

He served as an assistant professor at the Texas A&M University until 1989 working with C.D. Holland until he moved to Sydney, Australia at the beginning of 1990. He was senior lecturer at the University of New South Wales until he took up his current position of Professor of Sys-

tems and Control Technology in the Faculty of Applied Physics and the Faculty of Technical Chemistry of this University in the Summer of 1994.
