Wouter Reinder van Joolingen was born in Leiden on April 29, 1962. In 1980 he finished the VWO ('preparatory scientific education') at the 'Christelijk Lyceum Dr. W.A. Visser 't Hooft' in Leiden. For this department he works for the DELTA project SMISLE, a successor of SIMULATE, which aims at the implementation and evaluation of an authoring system for integrated simulation learning environments.
